

What you need to know about Nebraska's smoke-free air law.

Beginning June 1, all indoor workspaces and public places – including restaurants, bars, and businesses – will become smoke-free.

The new law will help protect employees and customers from the harmful effects of secondhand smoke.

Violation of the Nebraska Clean Indoor Air Act is a misdemeanor subject to fines. Both the individual and the business or establishment can be fined under this law.
